

Mezzo-soprano Jessie Shulman is an accomplished concert soloist, chamber musician, and SAG-AFTRA session singer based in Los Angeles. Recent solo performances include Mahler lieder (Unbound Chamber Music Festival), Mozart's *Requiem* and Fanny Mendelssohn's *Oratorium nach Bildern der Bibel* (LA Master Chorale), and Schubert and Brahms lieder (South Bay Chamber Music Society). Other highlights include Martinů's *Nový špalíček* (New Hollywood String Quartet), Handel's *Messiah* (LAMC), Ravel's *Chansons madécasses* (NHSQ), and Duruflé's *Requiem* (LAMC).
